Scoring

This qualifier will be run as a two-phase event, SJ and XC, the XC will follow the SJ immediately without a break, separate times will be recorded for each phase. The SJ will consist of a minimum of 6 fences, including a minimum of 1 double; the XC will consist of a minimum of 6 further obstacles, including the water complex to replicate a similar scenario to that of the championship course.

Scoring (each phase) summary.

First disobedience: 10 penalties Second disobedience: 20 penalties Third disobedience: Elimination

Knock-down: 5 penalties. Note the XC fences will all be solid obstacles so this will not apply here.

Time faults; 0.4 penalties each second over the relevant time.

Notes

- Eligibility: see the BRC handbook.
- Tack and turnout: see the BRC handbook. Number bibs must be worn, and competitors must print their own number.
- For each club entering a team, they must supply two volunteers per team entered for 2 hours of service. Times of volunteer service will be notified to the team manager, and we will try and ensure these times are compatible with team class times, though this cannot be guaranteed.
- This qualifier to be run on grass which fully replicates the championships at Aston-Le-Walls, Daventry which is also entirely on grass.
- Hats meeting current standards must be always worn when mounted. Body protectors up to current standard are required for both phases as there is no break between.
- Entries close on Wednesday 7th September and times will be provided no later than Thursday 15th September, including volunteers allocated slots.
- Declarations must be emailed to nickyday917@hotmail.co.uk no later than Wednesday 14th September to ensure teams match those that are declared.
- It is the team manager's responsibility to check flu vaccination records prior to declarations being made. The Secretary will check them on the day and Qualifying entries must show them prior to competing.
